parks, and also it is known that one of our forests, Nyungwe National Park, has in it's surface the source of the Nile River which has always had a great importance and impact to the lives of the people in different countries of Eastern and Northern Africa.

Rwanda Development Board (RDB), an institution that has the parks and their species in it's charge, said that some species were disappearing because of not having clear strategies about how to protect the parks and says that the poachers have had their fair share in the disappearance of those species. So, it is very important as Rwandans to protect our environmental heritage because we are one of the few countries that shelters the disappearing species, the mountain gorillas.

While the government of Rwanda is establishing different programs to conserve and preserve national parks and their species, the problem that remains is the state of mind of some citizens about the importance of the biodiversity to their daily


